

Domaine La Soumade's 2018 'Cuvée Confiance' Rasteau will introduce itself to you with a deeply concentrated red. Notes of mouthwatering cherry stand tall with the backdrop of crushed stones, garrigue, and coffee grinds to support it. Its finish and long and accompanied by bright acidity.

2018's Southern Rhône Vintage enjoyed a very hot and dry summer, resulting in juicy, generous reds and whites, with outstanding outcomes. Domaine de l'Espigouette's wines are structured and age worthy.

Cuvée Confiance is Domaine La Soumade's top cuvée made from their oldest vines, 50-100 years old. Hand-harvested when at their optimum ripeness, the grapes are hand-sorted in the vineyard and then again at the winery. After fermentation, the wine is aged 18-months in demimuids.

Founded by André Roméro in 1979, Domaine La Soumade has since grown to include his son Frédéric joining the winery team in 1996, a new modern winery in 2002, and that same year, a partnership with reknown consultant Stéphane Derenoncourt. Through their joined efforts, the name and quality of Rasteau wines now command the attention of the world. The estate covers 64 acres in Rasteau and 3 acres in Gigondas. "Agriculture raisonnée" is practiced in all the vineyards, which means that the vines are only treated when it is absolutely necessary. By doing so, it maximizes the characteristic of the clay-limestone terroir.

Domaine la Soumade is the story of one man, André Roméro, a passionate wine lover who founded the Domaine in 1979. Today he and his son, Frédéric, work to continue the tradition of creating beautifully balanced wines filled with a signature finesse. A new winery was built in 2002 and Stéphane Derenoncourt was brought on as the consultant winemaker. (Stéphane was declared by Wine Spectator in November 2010 to be the "the world's hottest winemaker.")
