



CHÂTEAU TERRE DE GRAND

« BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR »

This wine initially presents with a dark ruby color. The nose and pallet are full of chocolate, mocha, and cherries. It holds a light to medium body with an impressive nutty finish. All in all, this is a savory red that will more than shine at the dinner table.

The vineyards of Château Terre De Grand are located in the municipality of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens in the southwestern area of Saint-Émilion along the right bank of the Dordogne River. These vineyards are named after a castle where the majority of vineyards are located.

Château Terre de Grand's grapes are harvested by plot and varietals when they are at their peak ripeness. Fermentation is done in temperature-controlled vats and a long maceration is done to extract a deep color and rich aromatics and flavors. The wine ages a further 10-12 months in vats before bottling. Today, Chateau Terre de Grand's vineyards produce award-winning wines and are a credit to the Lacoste family heritage.

This family-run Domaine has been owned by the Lacoste family for at least five generations. Today, Mrs. Lacoste is the present owner of the vineyards. Her great-grandfather was a founding member of the Union of Saint-Émilion Producers at its creation in 1931. It allowed the Lacoste family to keep their land and vineyards while keeping the expenses down of a building and/or maintaining vinification, aging and storage facilities for the wines they made.
