Appellation Bordeaux Supérieur

Château Saint-Elme is a traditionally styled Merlot-dominated Bordeaux Supérieur. Located near the village of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens, this estate is a proof that Bordeaux can still offer a very approachable claret.

sandy

Area under vine:

8.8 hectares

Varieties:

95% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc

Average age of the vines :

35 years

Winemaking:

Harvesting plot by plot and variety by variety.

100% gravity-transferred.


Traditional Bordeaux vinification performed in thermo-regulated cement vats.

Ageing: 12 to 14 months in vats

Tasting notes:

This has all the pleasing Merlot fruit associate with the right bank together with good structure and excellent length of flavour.

Serving:

 Serve this wine at room temperature. It is great on its own and a good partner for cold meats, light picnic or buffet dishes and mild creamy cheeses.
